State of Illinois Health Requirements for the 2023-2024 School Year

- Please note that all Physical Exams, Immunizations, and Vision Exams are due by October 15th of the school year.
- If a grade level is not listed below, there are no additional requirements as long as previous requirements are up-to-date.
- Students who are enrolling in an Illinois school for the first time must provide (1) a
 completed State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination, (2) a completed
 immunization record, and (3) a completed State of Illinois Eye Examination Report.
 - All three required forms must be dated within one year of the first day of school.
- Sports physicals may not be used as the required Child Health Examination.

Preschool Students (PK3 students or new PK4 students)

- State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination

- Complete immunization record signed by a doctor: (4) DTap, (3) Polio, (4) Hib, (3) HepB, (1) MMR, (1) Varicella, (4) Pneumococcal

- State of Illinois Proof of Dental Examination due May 15th of school year (dated within 18 months of May 15th deadline)
- Birth Certificate (if not already on file at SCA)

Second Grade Students

 State of Illinois Proof of Dental Examination due May 15th of school year (dated within 18 months of May 15th deadline)

Sixth Grade Students

- State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination (sports physical NOT acceptable
 Parents, please complete yes/no questions on the back; then sign and date form.
- Complete immunization record signed by a doctor, including: (1) Tdap and (1) Meningitis
- State of Illinois Proof of Dental Examination due May 15th of school year (dated within 18 months of May 15th deadline)
